ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES (not included in the kit)

- White Glue/PVA (you'll receive a small bottle that may suffice, but it is refillable)
- Double-sided tape (1/4" or 1/2")

TOOLS:

- Pencil
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Cutting mat
- Craft knife
- Eraser
- Small glue brush (1/4" children's or artist's paintbrush)
- Foam brush (1" wide or so)
- Tapes

Optional but helpful tools:

- Metal triangle
- Small hand saw (see above under balsa wood; or use a a Japanese, jeweler's or hobby saw)
- Awl
- Bone folder
- Hole punches
- Deckled edge scissors
